Public Education

We are working to prevent legislation introduced last session that automatically holds back any third grader who fails a reading assessment. The bill doesn't provide any extra remediation for these students. A workgroup met and issued a recommendation in keeping with best practices about helping students with reading difficulties. We are now helping to draft a new bill that will incorporate the key components of the report, including remediation and funding to pay for the extra cost this kind of program requires.

Your Rights

We are fighting legislation that would stop you from doing any union business during the school day. If passed, bargaining, grievances, and all union/management collaboration would have to be done after school.

Your Wallet

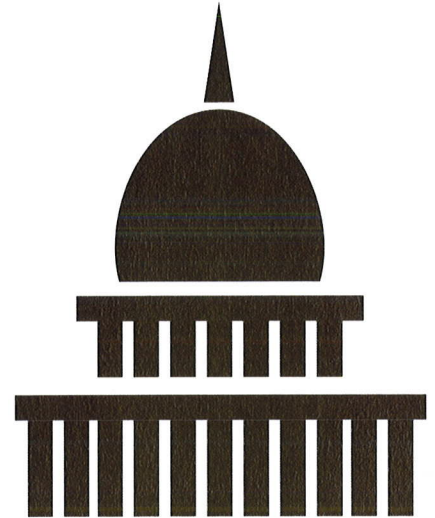
